To write a diary from Passepartout's point of view about his journey around the world.

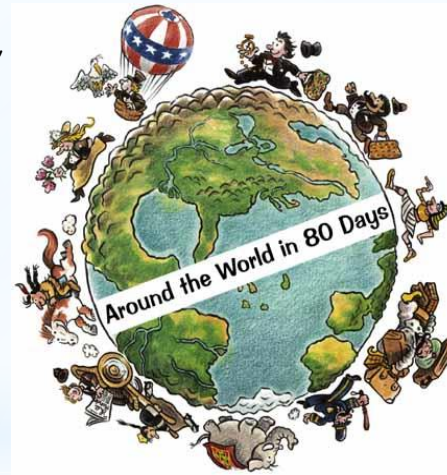
To explore my knowledge of continents, countries, climate, temperature and population.
